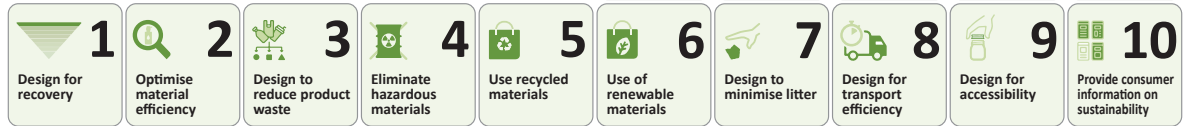


OVERVIEW OF THE COURSE :
