UPGRADE TO FELLOW

The grade of Fellow is the highest recognition to Australian Institute of Packaging Members, and as such it is important to preserve the integrity of the grade.

The key requirement is a significant and sustained contribution to the technology, science or application to packaging.

It is important to recognise the environment in which such significant contributions may be made. For example a Member working in packaging research or academia may be regarded as an ideal candidate and having greater opportunity for contribution.

In such cases the assessment should be made more stringent to compensate Members working in mainstream activities who may have less opportunity for such significant contribution, but nevertheless be equally deserving of recognition. In such cases due weighting shall be given to the opportunities which are available and assess accordingly.

Length of service or support of AIP activities is not sufficient on its own to constitute the awarding of this grade. A Distinguished Service Award may be more appropriate for such recognition.

In summary the attainment of the grade Fellow should be achieved by AIP Members from any background always bearing in mind that their contribution must be assessed as outstanding and is accompanied by a sustained record of contribution to the industry and field they work in.
